

 The boy said yes and gave his email adress.
- That person sent him a file.









- The boy loaded the file. His father's internet bank account was robbed in 2018.
- The father learned from the police that it was robbed because of the file his son uploaded.









- There is a virtual chat group that students created in Ünye.
- A 13 year-old girl student met a boy. She thought he was athe the same age with her. She shared his personal information with him like his home adress.
- One day, she visited a family friend with her family and chatted him on her tablet.











- She wrote to him they were not at home.
- They returned home and saw that their house was robbed.
- They went to the police.
- A few months later, the robbers were caught and told how they robbed the house.
- The robbers explained they met children in chat rooms and robbed their houses.
